## **The Southern Pines Police Department Announces an Additional “Operation Leader” Update Federal Sentencing of Arrested Suspects**

Southern Pines NC – On February 20, 2018, the Southern Pines Police Department executed the first of several planned actions bringing to an end a year-long investigation titled “Operation Leader.” Arrested during this operation were **Lee Marvin Harris Junior**, age 32, of Aberdeen and Charlotte, North Carolina, **Lee Marvin Harris Senior**, age 58, of Aberdeen, North Carolina, **Lamar Orlando Sealy**, age 33, of Southern Pines, North Carolina, **Lisa Ann Duncan Hanami**, age 31, of Charlotte, North Carolina, **Christian Jovonn Terry**, age 32, of Southern Pines, North Carolina, **Shuanda Bridges Fox**, age 49, of Sanford, North Carolina, **Gonzalo Cervantes Gomez**, age 27, of Misatlanta, Mexico, and **Calvin Deangelo Fox** age 32, of Sanford, North Carolina.

During the February 20, 2018 tactical operation, the following items of evidence were recovered across multiple jurisdictions in North Carolina: Over twenty (20) kilograms of Cocaine, two (2) pounds of Crystal Methamphetamine, five (5) ounces of Heroin, six (6) Firearms (one listed as stolen), in excess of \$100,000.00 U.S. Currency, and one (1) 2009 Toyota Venza.

With the assistance of or Federal Bureau of Investigation and the United States District Court for the Middle District of North Carolina, suspects Lee Marvin Harris Junior, Lamar Orlando Sealy, Christian Jovonn Terry and Gonzalo Cervantes Gomez all appeared in a United States Federal Court in Greensboro, North Carolina. The following represents the results of these federal court proceedings:

**Lee Marvin Harris Junior** – Entered a guilty plea to the charge of Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine and subsequently sentenced to serve eighty four (84) months in federal prison, to be followed by six (6) years of supervised release.

**Lamar Orlando Sealy** – Entered a guilty plea to the charge of Conspiracy to Distribute Cocaine and subsequently sentenced to serve fifty one (51) months in federal prison, to be followed by five (5) years of supervised release.

**Christian Jovonn Terry** - Entered a guilty plea to the charge of Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine and subsequently sentenced to serve forty one (41) months in federal prison, followed by three (3) years of supervised release.

**Gonzalo Cervantes Gomez** - Entered a guilty plea to the charge of Conspiracy to Distribute Cocaine Hydrochloride and subsequently sentenced to serve one hundred and thirty five (135) months in federal prison, to be followed by five (5) years of supervised release.

Several criminal proceedings in Moore County and Lee County Superior Courts remain in progress for those defendants who are being prosecuted on the state law enforcement level.

The Southern Pines Police Department would like once again to take this opportunity to thank the following departments/agencies for participating in this comprehensive investigation: Federal Bureau of Investigation, State Bureau of Investigation, Aberdeen Police Department, Lee County Sheriff’s Office, Charlotte Mecklenburg Police Department, Winston Salem Police Department, Davie County Sheriff’s Office, the United States District Court for the Middle District of North Carolina and the North Carolina National Guard.
