**INDUSTRIAL BASKETBALL LEAGUE
PLAYER CONTRACT / CODE OF CONDUCT**

All industrial basketball players and coaches shall be guided by the following:

- 1) No player or coach shall refuse to abide by an official's or Southern Pines Recreation & Parks Staff Member decision.
- 2) No player or coach shall be guilty of objectionable demonstrations of dissent at an official's decision by throwing the ball or other equipment.
- 3) No player shall, other than team captain, discuss with an official in any manner, the decision reached by an official.
- 4) No player shall be guilty of using unnecessary rough tactics in the play of the game against the body, and persons of an opposing player.
- 5) No player or coach shall at any time, lay a hand, push, shove, strike, or threaten to strike an official or Southern Pines Recreation & Parks Staff Member.
- 6) No player or coach shall be guilty of verbal abuse upon any official for any real or imaginary wrong decision or judgement.
- 7) No player or coach shall be guilty of physical attack as an aggressor upon any player, official, spectator, or Southern Pines Recreation and Parks Staff Member.
- 8) No player or coach shall be guilty of allowing team followers (ex. Wives, relatives, friends) to heckle any official, scorekeeper, or league supervisor. It will be the coach's responsibility to control crowds behind his team bench or on game site. If the manager cannot control the crowds, he may obtain assistance from the league supervisor.
- 9) I hereby give my permission to participate in the adult industrial basketball program. I know that with any sport there is possibility of serious injuries. I, therefore, will assume all responsibilities for any accident or injury that may occur.

Penalty: Ejection from the game by the officials: A player who is ejected from a game will be required to leave Town of Southern Pines Property promptly and be suspended for a minimum of two (2) games. If a player does not o leave after ejection, the umpires will forfeit the game.

Suspension: Managers must see that their ejected player leaves promptly.

If a player is ejected a second time, they may be suspended for the remainder of the season. If circumstance warrant, player may be suspended from participation in any competitive program, and/or facilities of the Southern Pines Recreation & Parks Dept. indefinitely!

NOTE: Justification is not a point of argument concerning code of conduct.
